OREGRO'S WILDFLOWERS & MIXES

MOUNTAIN MEADOW WILDFLOWER MIX (SEEDING RATE OF 20#/ACRE)

This mix is designed for alpine conditions in and around 3,500 to 8,000 ft. elevations. Mountain Meadow will bloom mostly in the spring and early summer, and contains annual and perennial flowers. Growing to a height of 20" - 30" depending on available water. Colors are blue, white, yellow and lavender. Should be planted in the fall for spring bloom.

SO CAL WILDFLOWER MIX (SEEDING RATE OF 20#/ACRE)

The colors of blue, orange, white and red make this mix a standout in Southern California landscapes. So Cal Wildflower Mix will do well from the coast to the arid inland valleys of this region. Plant seeds in the fall for spring bloom, growing to a height of 30".

LOW GROW WILDFLOWER MIX (SEEDING RATE OF 10#/ACRE)

If you need to keep it low, Low Grow is the way to go. Maximum height of this mix is only 15" in ideal conditions. Mix contains perennial and annual flowers, of red, orange, and white. Mix will bloom and grow most of the year in and around Southern California.

DESERT BREEZE WILDFLOWER MIX (SEEDING RATE OF 7#/ACRE)

Our Desert Breeze Wildflowers will make your desert location come alive with colors similar to the desert blooms of spring after abundant winter rains. This specially collected annual seed mix, of assorted colors, will bloom and drop seed for next year's show. This mix grows to a height of 15".
